Grading Policy:

- Weekly grades worth 130 pts. will be given in all 3 subjects of the ACT course (A point total for the week will be entered into the Grade Portal.) If you or your parents wish to see what assignments and points for individual assignments please see your teacher. These grades will be made up of daily assignments aimed at skills to improve your performance on the ACT Test in March. You will be given a minimum of 6 full length practice science tests (40 questions in 35 minutes for science) on block days. Your grade will be made up of group work, individual tasks, computer activities, timed practice tests, etc.
- In addition, there will be a College Project that you will research 3-5 Colleges or Universities that you are interested in attending. You will be required to write a 3-5 page paper and give a 2-3 minute presentation on your Top School.
- We will switch sections each 6 weeks for the 1st semester. If you are starting the course with Mr. Bonanno (Science) you will go to Ms. Savage (English) 2nd, followed by Mrs. Smithson (Math) 3rd. They will switch to their 2nd rotation on Monday Sept. 19th and their 3rd rotation on Monday Oct. 31st.
- Since this is a semester course the guidelines for final exam exemptions will apply. However, any student will be allowed to take a mini-ACT timed Midterm containing a partial Math/Reading/English/Science component if they would like to try to improve their semester average. The Midterm counts 25%.
